

## North Texas Region Results Database 2004 Rankings Process

### For Club Directors

#### **Result Posting Process for Club Directors:**

As discussed in the Directors Meeting in September, we will be using an online process for teams to submit their result information to the Region. This information will be used to determine seeding for local tournaments, regional rankings posted each month, and rankings provided to the National Office for seeding in Junior National Qualifier Tournaments. **It is the responsibility for Club Directors to submit their teams results if they want their teams to be ranked.**

The Results process is set up so Club Directors may delegate their responsibilities to others without handing out Club Passwords. This is achieved by each team having their own Team Site with their password assigned by the Club Director.

*To begin with, the Team Password for each team has been assigned to be the same as your Club password for the Director's Web.*

#### **Below are instructions for assigning a password for the Team Sites...**

1. Log-in to the Director's Web from the North Texas Region Registration site.

2. From your Club's Status Page, a list of teams within your club is listed in the top-left blue box labeled "Teams currently in database for..."
3. To the Right of each team listed, is a link that says "(edit)". Click on the "edit" link for the team you wish to select.
4. You will be sent to the team information page. At the bottom of the page is a text box labeled "Team Password". This is the password for that team to use in the "Team Site". Change this password to whatever to wish, and provide this password to the person you want to be responsible for submitting that team's results.
5. Repeat steps 3 & 4 for each team.

#### **Below are instructions for Club Directors submitting Team Result Information...**

Club Directors have the advantage to go directly into their teams' result sites without logging in to each team.

1. At the bottom of the Director's Web is a section titled "Additional Club Pages". Within this section is a link "Results Database". *Click this link.*
2. This will take you to a list of your teams. Click on the team you wish.
3. From here, follow the instructions provided for "2004 Rankings Process For Club Coaches" and begin with step #5.

#### **How the Rankings Process Works...**

Posted on the Log-in Page will be the deadline dates to have your results into the database for the next month's rankings.

#### **A. Responsibilities of the Ranking Committee**

- Assign weight-range for tournament categories
- Assign each tournament and division to a category
- Compare Tournament finishes with results posted by clubs
- Determine the appropriate multipliers for head-to-head competition formula

#### **B. Head-to-Head Competition:**

A detailed description of the formulas and process of the Ranking System is available to everyone upon request. In this document, it is our intension to inform the user of what information is utilized for the Head-to-Head process and how it affects your team(s).

After a team has provided their result information for a tournament, that team has the option to report match results (opponent's name and Win, Loss, or Split). The only information that will be seen by the Ranking System is all matches marked with a "WIN". Due to the opportunity open for selective match input, the Ranking System database will not look at matches marked with a "LOSS". *Therefore, it will not hurt a club or team to input losses into the system.*

#### **C. Checks and Balances:**

There will be two methods used to police the Ranking System.

1. It will be the Ranking Committee's responsibility to compare tournament finishes with results posted by clubs.
2. All Tournament Results and Head-to-Head match results will be made available to the public on the North Texas Region website. In addition, it is our intention to have a link from the "Directors Web" to view a list of all the teams that have submitted Match information affecting one of your teams. In other words, a director can see a list of every team that has inputted results that show their team has defeated your team.
